

## ***FINAL REMINDER***

Dear **Member**,

This serves as a final reminder to members **who have not taken action** with regard to checking account changes that went into effect earlier this year. Paper Checks, Electronic Debits, and Electronic Credits must be routed through Greater Alliance Federal Credit Union's ABA Number (**2212-7587-6**) in order for them to be accepted beyond **November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009**. There will be no exceptions and after this date items processed without the updated information **will be returned unpaid**.

### **Paper Drafts**

If you have received a complimentary set of paper checks or have ordered new checks in recent months please make sure they are being used and that the old checks are destroyed. If you have not received new checks within the past few months, or you are not sure if you made the required changes please contact one of our service representatives at 201-599-5500 immediately.

### **Electronic Payments (Debits and Credits)**

For electronic payments to reach your account, electronic payment systems need to be set up with Greater Alliance FCU's ABA followed by your account number. The correct ABA number for Greater Alliance is **2212-7587-6**, and your account number can be found on the upper right corner of your monthly statement.

**If you answer "no" to any of these questions immediate action is required to prevent disruption with regard to your account:**

- Does the bottom of your active checkbook start with 2212-7587-6?
  - If so, are you using these checks?
- Are your electronic payments for Debits and Credits being processed using Greater Alliance's ABA (2212-7587-6) followed by your Account Number?
  - This can also include recurring items like social security and payroll payments

If necessary, please take action **today**, and we will continue to provide you with the, "**Greater Level of Service**", you deserve! If you have already taken care of the changes please disregard this letter.
